2016 Advanced Clean Transportation (ACT) Expo **Kicks Off at the Long Beach Convention Center**

More than 3,000 attendees convene in Southern California for the largest clean fleet event, co-hosted with the Electric Drive Transportation Association, NGV America, the Propane Education & Research Council, the North American Council for Freight Efficiency, and the California Hydrogen Business Council
